1. General Copyright Statement

BCES Conference Books are protected by the Bulgarian Copyright Law (adopted 1993, amended 1994, 1998, 2000, 2002, 2005, 2006, 2007, 2009, 2011, 2014, 2015, 2018, 2019, 2023, and 2024).

No part of BCES Conference Books may be reproduced or utilized in any form or by any means, electronic or mechanical, including photocopying, recording, or by any information storage and retrieval system, without permission in writing from the Bulgarian Comparative Education Society and individual authors.

2. Publisher's Rights

Upon accepting a paper for publication, the publisher, Bulgarian Comparative Education Society (BCES), reserves the exclusive right to publish, distribute, and archive the work in all forms and media, including print, electronic, and online formats.

3. Authors' Rights
