

## BCES CONFERENCE BOOKS PEER REVIEW PROCESS

The BCES Conference proceedings are peer-reviewed and published as **BCES Conference Books**. An International Editorial Board, consisting of an editor-in-chief and editorial team members, oversees each volume. The International Advisory Board provides additional guidance as an external consulting body.

The peer review process follows these steps:

1. **Submission:** Authors submit research papers that must be well-written, properly structured, and strictly adhere to BCES paper requirements. Submissions should present clear concepts, thorough analyses, and well-developed discussions.
2. **Initial Screening:** The editor-in-chief and relevant editorial team members evaluate the submissions and determine which papers will proceed to the review stage.
3. **Review:** Each paper is assessed by two independent reviewers, who are distinct from the editors. Members of the International Advisory Board may also participate in the review process.
4. **Recommendation:** Based on the reviewers' feedback, the editorial team evaluates the papers and recommends which should be included in their respective sections of the book.
5. **Final Decision:** The International Editorial Board makes the ultimate decision on the inclusion of papers in the volume.
